



- 1. Attach fixture mounting plate to junction box with J-box screws. Level mounting plate and secure to wall through auxiliary mounting holes.
- 2. Align slots in back of fixture with tabs on mounting plate. Hook onto mounting plate. Align holes in top of fixture with holes in top of mounting plate. Secure with screws provided.
- 3. Remove lens and reflector by loosening lens screws and clip.
- Make all wire connections in accordance with all national and local codes and push into junction box. 4.
- Reinstall reflector and lens. Secure with provided screws. 5.
