





## TYPICAL FIXTURE



1. Remove mounting plate from LED plate by loosening thumb nuts (Qty. 2).
2. Fasten the mounting plate to junction box with junction box screws (by other).
3. Make all necessary wire connections according to national and local electrical codes.
4. Fasten LED plate to mounting plate with provided thumb nuts.
5. Align the lens/trim assembly to the LED plate using the aligning assistant studs. Push the three lock pins into the lock pin slots on lamp plate and rotate the lens/trim assembly clockwise until tight.

**Caution!:** Be sure lens/trim assembly is securely closed.
